Sub: Application for letter of permission for functioning of State Homoeopathic Medical College and Hospital, Kasimpur Road, Chherat, Aligarh -202122, Uttar Pradesh with intake capacity of 125 seats (including EWS seats) for undergraduate (BHMS) course for the academic year 2025-26-regd.

Sir.

State Homoeopathic Medical College and Hospital has applied for permission for sanction of BHMS course with 125 UG seats (including EWS) for the academic year 2025-26. The College has submitted the Part I information in which the entire functional profile has been narrated. MARBH conducted Inspection on 20.05.2025 & 21.05.2025. The Medical Assessment and Rating Board has examined the College as to whether the college fulfils the Minimum Essential Standards as per the prevailing regulations under clauses 26 and 28 of the NCH Act 2020. On careful examination of the report, the Medical Assessment and Rating Board observed the following shortfalls: -

### 1. Teaching faculty.

- There are NO Teaching Faculty in departments of Human Physiology & Biochemistry, Homoeopathic Pharmacy and Gynecology /Obs.
- Other Departments have only One Faculty in each department. ii.
- iii. Such gross deficiencies of the teaching staff will badly impact the education quality and is very difficult to manage teaching after implementation of Competency Based Dynamic Curriculum.

As evident from above statement, many teachers are deficient against the requirement of 40 + 1 for 125 seats (including EWS) (As specified in MES, 2024). Pursuant to File. No. 3-2/MARBH/NCH/2025-26/162-169 dated 16/04/2025 issued by MARBH, a college can avail 10% relaxation against the required number of teachers for Academic Year 2025-26 only. After allowing relaxation of 10%, coilege still has a deficiency of many teachers.

### 2. HOSPITAL REQUIREMENTS:

College has deficiencies in Hospital staff, Non-teaching staff and Equipment's in the laboratory.

#### 3. Miscellaneous:

- NABL accreditation for clinical laboratory is not done. i.
- ii. NABH accreditation for hospital is not done.
- iii. Skill laboratory is not available.
- iv. Not Registered on AEBAS portal (though college is registered on Govt. based AYUSH Attendance mobile app.)

Though an undertaking is submitted by the Director, Homoeopathy, Uttar Pradesh (Prof. Arvind Kumar Verma), where it has been mentioned that the e-requisition is already been sent to UPPSC Prayagraj for various posts and the selection/appointment after interview is under progress and budget will be provided to all the concerned colleges to fulfill all the deficiencies, but non availability of teachers in many departments will surely affected the quality of teaching, Hence MARBH has decided to issue permission to State Homoeopathic Medical College and Hospital, Kasimpur Road, Chherat, Aligarh -202122, Uttar Pradesh for conducting BHMS course with intake capacity of 75 seats (including EWS) (reduced from sanctioned 125 seats including EWS seats) for the academic year 2025-26.

- 4. All admissions shall be made from NEET qualified candidates only. It is further informed that minimum 15% of undergraduate seats of the permitted intake capacity of 75 UG seats shall be treated as All India Quota. Counseling for seats under all India quotas shall be conducted by respective Counseling Authority of State/UT govt as designated by Central Government and counseling for the remaining 85% seats or as the case may be, shall be conducted by the concerned counseling authority of the state/UT.
- 5. The Category wise list of the selected candidates may be informed to the Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Homoeopathy after the process of admission is completed. Any admissions carried out other than NEET qualified students will not be approved by the Medical Assessment and Rating Board.
